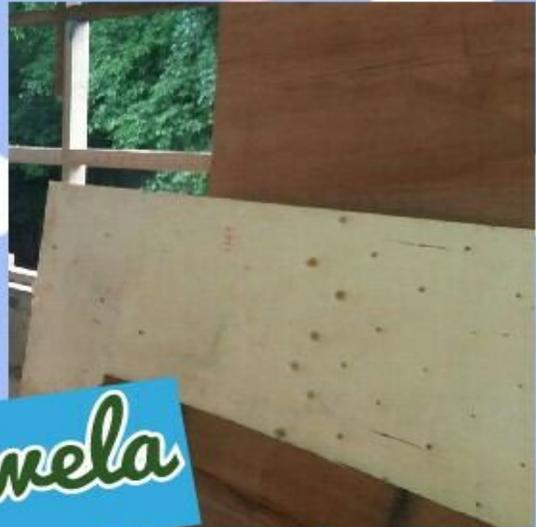

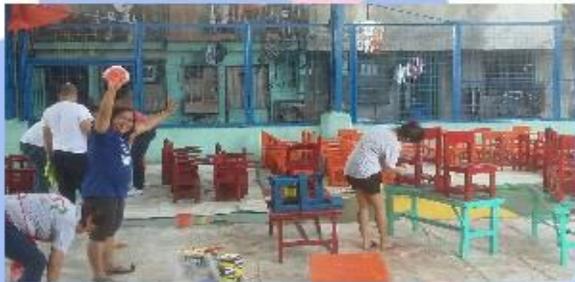
In our small way, we aim to contribute to a brighter future for the children by nurturing their dream for good education.
